## **Upgrade to children's centre brings 30 kindergarten places for Bayswater District families**

Local Bayswater families can now access high-quality early childhood services with the new Birch Street Children and Family Centre thanks to a \$600,000 investment by the Victorian Coalition Government.

Bayswater District MP Heidi Victoria said the upgraded centre provides 30 additional high-quality early years places at any one time.

"In the short term, not only has this centre provided more kindergarten places, it also brings many long-term benefits to local families, including giving children the best possible preparation for school."

Ms Victoria congratulated the Knox City Council for their contribution of \$363,000 towards the new children and family centre.

"The Coalition Government has invested \$900,000 in the City of Knox through record investments in early childhood infrastructure."

"This early years centre is a wonderful example of what can be achieved when state and local governments work hand-in-hand with the local community," Ms Victoria said.

Minister for Children and Early Childhood Development Wendy Lovell welcomed the upgraded Birch Street Children and Family Centre.
