## **New traffic signals at the intersection of Boronia Road, Tormore Road and Narcissus Avenue**

Local MPs Heidi Victoria and Nick Wakeling delivered another election commitment with the traffic signals at the intersection of Boronia Road, Tormore Road and Narcissus Avenue in Boronia switched on today.

Mrs Victoria said the \$1.3 million project responded to concerns from local residents to improve safety at the intersection.

“As a result of these works, residents and visitors to the area will be safer and drivers exiting Tormore Road and Narcissus Avenue can expect reduced delays during peak hours,” Mr Wakeling said.

“The improvements works have provided full signalised access onto Boronia Road for drivers leaving Tormore Road and Narcissus Avenue. The right turn lanes on Boronia Road have also been extended, which will increase capacity, minimising disruption to Boronia Road through-traffic.

“Boronia residents have been calling for safety improvements at this intersection for a long time and I’m pleased to see this important work completed today. The project has been delivered months ahead of schedule, reiterating the Victorian Coalition Government’s commitment to keeping Victorians safe.

A number of primary schools are close to this intersection and the commissioning of the traffic signals today will ensure the safety of our children and parents.

Thanks must go to the local action group, residents and members of local schools, Boronia Football and Cricket Clubs who campaigned strongly for this improvement. They asked, we listened and delivered.
